

Palo Grande and Naranjitas School Project

This project is a light construction/painting project for two schools in the southern communities of Palo Grande and Las Naranjitas, Honduras. These two schools are very difficult to get to, and need to be painted on the exterior and interior and the screens need to be repaired in the windows.. New bathrooms need to be built at the Naranjitas school because the current bathrooms are located on a hill and are starting to fall backwards off the steep incline behind them. This is dangerous for the students and they are begging to restrict the use of some of the units. In addition to painting the schools and fixing the bathrooms, we will provide the students with fluoride treatments and toothbrushes/toothpaste for dental hygiene and eye screening to identify those that need glasses. Those who need glasses will be taken to the nearest eye clinic in San Lorenzo for treatment. The first two days of work will be spent at the Palo Grande School and the Second two days at the Naranjitas School.
